Monday, July 9 is the deadline to register for the Special Election, to be held on Tuesday, August 7, 2018. The Stark County School Financing District for School Safety and Security and Mental Health has filed an issue with the Stark County Board of Elections for the August 7, 2018 Special Election. The Northwest Local School District and Tuslaw Local School District both overlap into Wayne County. The Stark County Board of Elections has graciously agreed to host the Wayne County voters affected by this election.

Voters in the Northwest and Tuslaw districts in Wayne County include:

Baughman #1 (43.05); Baughman #2 (44.05 & 44.07), and Chippewa #1 (53.04).

- Must be 18 years of age on or before the August 7, 2018 Special Election
- Must be a resident of Ohio 30 days prior to the day of the election
- You are not incarcerated for a felony conviction
- You have not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court
- You have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of election laws
