Monday, April 8, 2019 is the deadline to register for the Primary/Special Election to be held on Tuesday, May 7, 2019. Voters in the following districts will have items on the Primary/Special Election ballot: City of Orrville – **REPUBLICAN Primary ONLY**; Canaan Township; Dalton Local School District; Northwestern Local School District; Tuslaw Local School District (overlap from Stark County); Sterling Fire District (Milton Township).

Voters may visit www.MyOhioVote.com or www.votewayne.org to register online, check their voter registration, change their address, locate their polling place (*including temporary and permanent voting location changes*), view sample ballots, and find absentee voter information.

You can also register in person at one of the following locations by the registration deadline:

- Wayne County Board of Elections office- 200 Vanover St., Ste. 1, Wooster, OH 44691
Office hours are: Monday thru Friday, 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.
NOTE: The office will be OPEN Monday, April 8 until 9 p.m.-the last day for registration.
- The Ohio Secretary of State's Office
- BMV or Deputy Registrars
- Office of designated agencies, including:
 - The Department of Job and Family Services
 - The Department of Health (including WIC)
 - The Department of Mental Health
 - The Department of Developmental Disabilities
 - Any state-assisted college or university that provides assistance to disabled students
- County treasurer's office
- Any public library
- Any public high school or vocational school

Qualifications to register for this election:

- Must be a citizen of the United States
- Must be 18 years of age on or before the November 5, 2019 Election – *applies ONLY to the REPUBLICAN PRIMARY in the City of Orrville.*
- Must be a resident of Ohio 30 days prior to the day of the election
- You are not incarcerated for a felony conviction
- You have not been declared incompetent for voting purposes by a probate court
- You have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of election laws

In person absentee (early) voting will begin on Tuesday, April 9, 2019. Visit www.votewayne.org to view a calendar with in person absentee voting hours.
